We have just been through important but serious topics about Holy Week, Easter, Divine Mercy and the Year of Priests. 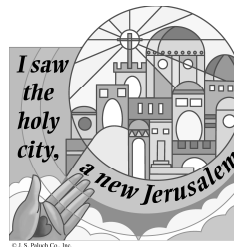
You can help us make this enjoyable fund raising event a big success in several ways:

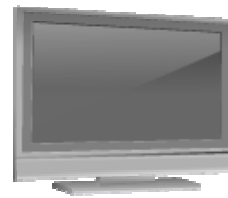
A Belated Thank-You

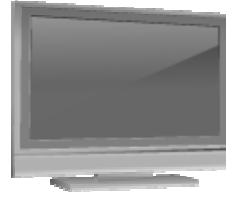
