MEXICO HAS 29 NEWLY CANONIZED SAINTS!!

Not so many Catholics in the U.S. know that our neighboring country, Mexico, has 29 newly canonized saints. Many Latinos and Mexican-Americans in the U.S. don't know much yet about the majority of these newly canonized saints who were killed, murdered and assassinated because for most they dared just to celebrate and attend the Eucharist. We are not talking of the persecution by the Roman Emperors in the first 3 centuries, but of the 19th century. Most of these saints were priests from the states of Jalisco, Zacatecas & Guerrero who did nothing but said Masses for their parishioners and parishioners who attended Mass. Many were shot by firing squad during the religious persecution against the Church under the anti-church President Calles from 1915-1937. I learned when I studied in Guadalajara that his government was hanging dead priests on telephone poles everywhere. The parishioners were so angered that they organized their own army and ambushed the government troops. Some Legion of Mary prayer groups organized the "Women's Brigade", armed themselves and fought the government soldiers. The first in the list is the famous Juan Diego in the 15th century but was canonized only recently during Pope JP II's last visit in 2002 because of lack of records about his life. The second was canonized 148 years ago. All the rest in Rome on May 21, 2000. The last in the list is the only woman, a nun. Next to the name is the year of canonization, status and the date and place of birth.

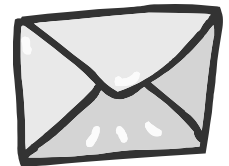

BOLETIN HISPANO

MEXICO TIENE 29 SANTOS RECIEN CANONIZADOS!!

No muchos católicos de Los Estados Unidos saben que nuestro país vecino, México tiene 29 Santos recién canonizados. Muchos Latinos y México-Americanos en los Estados Unidos no saben todavía de la mayoría de estos santos recién canonizados quienes fueron asesinados más que todos por atreverse a celebrar La Misa. No estamos hablando de la persecución de EL Emperador Romano en los primeros 3 siglos, pero en el siglo 19º. muchos de estos fueron sacerdotes de los estados de Jalisco, Zacatecas y Guerrero que no hicieron mas que celebrar misa para sus feligreses y feligreses que iban a misa. A muchos de ellos les dispararon durante la persecución contra la iglesia bajo el presidente Calles, que estaba en contra de la iglesia, entre los años 1915 y 1937. Cuando yo estude en Guadalajara, aprendí que su gobierno estaba colgando sacerdotes muertos en los postes de teléfono por doquier. Los feligreses estaban tan furiosos que formaron entre ellos sus propios batallones y emboscaron a las tropas del gobierno. Algunas fueron EL Grupo de Oración de La Legión de María que organizo "La Brigada de Mujeres", se armaron ellos mismos y combatieron a los soldados del gobierno. El primero en la lista fue el famoso Juan Diego en el siglo 15, pero fue canonizado recientemente durante el papado de Juan Pablo II en su visita el 2002 por su falta de documentación de su vida. El Segundo fue canonizado hace 148 años. El resto en Roma el 21 de Mayo del 2000. El último en la lista es la única mujer, una monja. A la par de su nombre esta el año de canonización, estado y el día y lugar de nacimiento.
