Dear Parishioners,

Thank you so much for your **warm and overwhelming welcome**. I'm still getting words of welcome after the Mass from many parishioners coming back from vacations, etc...

I thank **Fr. Diarmuid Casey** for that **beautiful letter** he wrote addressing you for the last time as your outgoing Pastor. If you haven't seen it, save a copy, for one day it may be a collector's item. I join in **thanking all the Holy Ghost fathers** who have **served St. Athanasius** in the last **34 years** and in particular, **Fr. Casey**, for serving as your **Pastor for 15 years** of his life. We cherish all the gifts from God that they have shared with us and for affirming the gifts of our community. We will remember these for a long time.

I thank Fr. Stasys, our handsome (don't be flattered) and young Parochial Vicar for accepting the request of Fr. Diarmuid to write the transition piece in this column about **"transition and spirituality"** (my description) in English and then at my request also in Spanish last week. I think it was well written.

Some of you are so kind to ask me **"How are you doing Fr. Oscar?"** A short answer is **"I'm doing fine and enjoying** my first days and week in our wonderful parish, **but I'm still a bit lost as to a number of things."** Among others, I'm still learning the **"Athanasian choreography"** (the particular movements at our sanctuary, how much wine to consecrate at each Mass, who to give communion first at the altar, how loud or soft should my voice be, how to determine if the wireless mike hidden under the thick robe is on or mute or off or low batt, where to find things in the rectory and sacristy, etc...). Last weekend I had three sick calls from Stanford Hospital and I could not find my sick call bags. So I had to borrow and later assembled one myself. **It's somewhat frustrating** at times but I'm trying to remind myself to take it easy and that is normal when relocating to another place. So please be patient with me, too. Those of you who have relocated recently know how this can be very stressful.

As soon as I am settled, I would like to **meet first** with our hard working **Transition Team** who has done a **great work** since last year, then with our **Pastoral Council**. I will surely use the various recommendations to guide me in my Pastorship and I need their **guidance and support** in these coming weeks and months. I also thank you all for **welcoming me** and even inviting me to the farewell meeting and send off for Frs. Diarmuid and John. I also like to **meet with all active groups** in our Parish ASAP. **Thanks to St. Vincent de Paul and the Senior Group** for the **luncheon invitations**. Next week I plan to share with you how and what I might plan to write in this (seldom read? Often read?) Pastor's Column. I am not a seasoned writer like Fr. Casey.

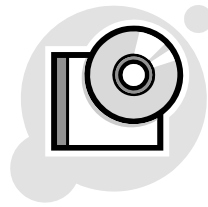
